

Coronavirus Crisis Response



Ceres Community Project is part of Marin and Sonoma County's emergency food response during COVID-19. At this time, we are prioritizing our services for the following populations:

- People with acute or chronic health challenges, whose household incomes are below 400% of the federal poverty level, and who do not have a caregiver or family member to help them with meals
- People who have been diagnosed with COVID-19 who are self-quarantining or who have been discharged from the hospital, and who lack financial and family support to prepare meals
- Medically fragile people who are required to shelter in place to protect their health, who are living at or below 200% of the federal poverty level, and who lack family support to prepare meals

If you meet our criteria, call our Client Intake Line and someone will get back to you in the next 48 business hours to verify your eligibility and complete an intake.

We are currently working to expand our service capacity to meet growing demand. If you complete an intake with our Client Care Team, we will move you into service as quickly as we are able.
